Monthly appointments are available for households that reside within the White Bear School District. Neighbors are able to choose from the following items: fresh produce, dairy, meat, bread and non-perishable pantry items.

Bonus Fridays

Weekly appointments are available every Friday from 9 - noon to pick-up fresh produce.

KID Packs

Parents or guardians of White Bear School District students enrolled in the School Meal program can register through their school office. Bags are brought home with students on Friday.
